The scholarship is limited to student from Whitman County who wishes to pursue a course of study or training in the agricultural field.

The applicant must supply the Whitman County Cattlemen's Association Scholarship Review Committee with the following information.

1. Completed application form.
2. A one-page essay based on the applicant's goals and training plans in an agricultural field.
3. A copy of the current high school transcript with a cumulative grade point average.
4. A letter of recommendation from any member of the Whitman County Cattlemen's Association.
